Shoot Off Format

TO QUALIFY:

- You must have shot the entire 50 target course and handed in the score by 10:00 am Sunday morning.
 - The Top 5 scores from the 50 target range in the adult classes will advance to the Sunday Shoot Off.
 - If there are any ties within the top 5 they will All advance to the Shoot Off
 - This will make 8 groups of 5+ shooters (MMT, MR, MLB, MSB, WMT, WR, WLB, WSB) If any shooter in the top 5 can NOT participate in the Sunday Shoot Off then the group will be filled by alternate shooters starting with the 6th place score and continuing down, but not below 10th place.
 - The Shoot off will consist of 10 to 15 targets and be held on the Rifle Range
 - Scoring for the Shoot Off will be 11, 10, & 8 for kills, and 0 for a wound.
 - An arrow touching the line of a greater scoring area shall be given the higher score.
 - All shooters will start from scratch (0), NO scores from the initial 50 target shoot will carry into the Sunday Shoot Off.
 - **NO** binoculars/rangefinders will be allowed on the range during the Sunday Shoot Off.
 - The Shoot Off will begin ASAP after 10:00 am on Sunday.
 - You may only shoot one class in the Shoot Off. If you qualify for more than one you will shoot in the division that you hold the higher rank in.
